

Agribusiness

India's GDP growth rate and growth in agriculture sector are correlated. With nearly 70% of our population and more than 50% of the total work force depending on agriculture and allied activities, agriculture meets the basic needs of India's growing population. Further, direct linkage of agriculture with the industry is increasing owing to changing and rising demand for processed agricultural commodities and goods by consumers.

Activities in agriculture does not encompass the production side only, it also involves the post harvest management which is presently the crucial factor. Agribusiness refers to the post harvest end where trade gets initiated on the produce. India's share in the international agribusiness is negligible, though it is endowed with varied types of agro-climatic conditions and zones suitable for production of vast number of agriculture crops.

Agribusiness activity for a particular crop can start in the clusters of surplus producing zones/districts. Based on the information available from potential linked plans of NABARD, action plan of National Horticulture Mission and Horticulture Technology Mission for North Eastern States, J & K, HP & Uttaranchal, the Potential States and districts have been identified. Action plan for agribusiness development in close association with commercial banks and State SFAC, have been drawn for the next two years in these district.

SCHEME FOR AGRIBUSINESS DEVELOPMENT AT A GLANCE

Small Farmers' Agribusiness Consortium, Ministry of Agriculture, is implementing the schemes of project development facility and venture capital assistance for development of agribusiness in the country in association with commercial banks

1. **Venture Capital:** To promote private investments in agri-business projects engaged in value addition of crops with the participation of commercial banks and State level SFAC's.
 - a. Equity participation in agribusiness projects upto 10% of the total project cost, or 26% of the total project equity or Rs.75 lakhs whichever is lower.
 - b. In special cases, higher amount of venture capital assistance can be considered in case of agribusiness projects for value addition located in hilly and North Eastern States and the projects recommended by State agencies/ State SFAC's.
2. **Project Development Facility (PDF) :** To provide financial assistance to agripreneurs, farmers and producer groups for the preparation of bankable Detailed Project Reports (DPR) on a case to case basis.
3. **Eligibility Criteria for funding**
 - a. Value addition projects should be in agriculture or allied sector like horticulture, apiculture, medicinal and aromatic plants, spices, cashew nut, coconut and fisheries etc. excluding poultry and dairy projects.
 - b. Project should provide assured market to farmers/ producer groups.
 - a) Cost of proposed projects must be of Rs. 50 lakhs in general and Rs. 25 lakhs in case of NE states and other hilly areas.
 - b) Project must encourage farmers to diversify into high value crops, to increase farm incomes.
 - c) Project should be accepted by banks for grant of term loan.
4. **Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)** signed with Commercial Banks for smooth implementation of the scheme.
